Summer is here once again and we are anxious to provide a safe and fun atmosphere for your child. We would like to welcome you to SJP II Regional School Summer Day Camp and provide you with some information that will help make this program a success. If there is an issue and you need to get a hold of someone right away, please call our office at (631) 727-1650.

This summer, come join us for fun activities, dress up days, and more from **Kindergarten to 5th grade**.

COST: Due to busy summer schedules children have the opportunity of attending on a weekly basis. The cost per week will be \$200 per child. If you wish for your child to attend all three weeks there will be a flat rate of \$500 per child. The minimum amount of

participants are 25 children in order to ensure camp will be in session. If the minimum is not met, notification and refunds will be provided.

REGISTRATION: In order to sign your child up for camp, please submit the registration form as well as **half of the total payment for the initial payment**. We can only guarantee spots for camp upon receipt of the required paperwork and the deposit. We cannot hold spots based on a verbal commitment. Initial payments are due **March 4th**. Final payments for camp are due by **June 21st**. If paying by check, please make it payable to St. John Paul II Regional School. All payment are to be handed in to the main office in a labeled envelope.

DROP OFF: Please drop off your child at 8:30 am. After 9:00 am, organized activities start and camp may be outside, or inside. If that is the case, a sign will be posted outside on the door letting you know to look for the camp outside (usually near the playground). The Summer Program staff will be there to meet you and your child and check them in. All children must be signed in by a parent/guardian. Please notify the staff at this time if somebody different will be picking up your child. DO NOT drop your children off in the front office.

PICK UP: Please pick up your child at the same place you dropped them off, unless there is a sign letting you know that they are outside playing. Camp will be close to the office or in the multipurpose room by 12:00 pm every afternoon, if you pick your child up before that, a sign will be posted with their location. Children have to be signed out by parent/guardian/designated person each day. Camp staff will be available at all times. Please do not drop off or pick up your child without locating appropriate staff!

CAMP DRESS ATTIRE: The following dress code is to assure that no one will feel offended or uncomfortable during his or her time at camp. If you choose to dress inappropriately, you will be asked to change. Please be advised that the following dress code will be enforced for all individuals attending the camp including volunteers.

- 1. Clothing: All clothing shall be neat, clean, and acceptable.
- 2. Articles of clothing which display profanity, products, or slogans which promote non christian values are prohibited.
- 3. Excessively baggy or tight clothing are prohibited.
- 4. Items of clothing which expose bare midriffs, bare chests, undergarments, or that are transparent are prohibited. Tank tops straps wider than 1 inch are permitted. Please be advised spaghetti straps, shirts which expose a bare back, halter tops, and tube tops are prohibited.
- 5. Shoes: Sandals or any open toed shoes and shoes without backs will be prohibited. Sneakers are advised.

DAILY ITEMS TO BRING: Sunscreen, a snack for morning, and a reusable water bottle with child's name on it. We have an endless supply of drinking water, but a limited supply of cups. Please help us keep your costs down by sending a reusable water bottle with your child every day!

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED: Please leave money, electronic devices, and toys at home. We will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

OPENING DAY: At the beginning of each week, there will be an outline of the week's activities. Our staff will introduce themselves and go over any basic ground rules.

RAINY DAYS: Our program will not be cancelled due to rain. Drop off and pick up will be at the same location as noted above.

SPECIAL EVENTS & SCHEDULES: Check our weekly calendars to determine necessary clothing or items to bring for the planned activities. These calendars will be posted on our website and available in our office and when you pick up/drop off your child. Please

send sunscreen and a water bottle with your child every day as we will be outside in the sun.

SNACK: Each day participants need to bring a snack for the morning. Lunches are not provided and snacks are generally not provided. Please do not send food that needs to be prepared, refrigerated or heated! Snacks may be provided at times for different activities, so please let us know if your child has any specific food allergies. Please note when packing snacks our school is a nut free.

GROUND RULES: It is our goal to ensure that each child has an enjoyable and fulfilling experience as a participant in our program. We will always emphasize positive ways to deal with difficult situations. Children must stay with their designated camp leader. They must ask permission to use the restroom, join other activities, early departure, etc. This is to ensure the safety of the campers. Everyone is here to have fun! Bullying, dangerous play and violence will not be tolerated. Our policies on discipline include verbal warnings, one-on-one discussions, time outs, parent conferences, and possible removal from the program.
